Procurement: ANAC and IVASS join the Memorandum of Understanding between the Bank of Italy, Consob and Antitrust

The National Anti-Corruption Authority (ANAC) and the Insurance Supervisory Authority (IVASS) have joined the <u>Memorandum of Understanding</u>, signed in <u>November 2018</u>, between the Bank of Italy, the National Commission for Listed Companies and the Stock Exchange (CONSOB) and the Antitrust Authority (AGCM) the shared management of joint procurement procedures pursuant to the provisions in legislative decree no. 50 of 18 April 2016.

The Memorandum defines the coordination arrangements between the subscribing Authorities in order to identify joint strategies for the purchase of works, services and goods, and is functional to the achievement of cost savings.

For this purpose a technical panel responsible for guidance, coordination and supervision will be set up.

The Memorandum of Understanding represents a best practice on the national scene and lays the foundations for enhancing the quality of public procurement, also in terms of transparency and anti-corruption.
